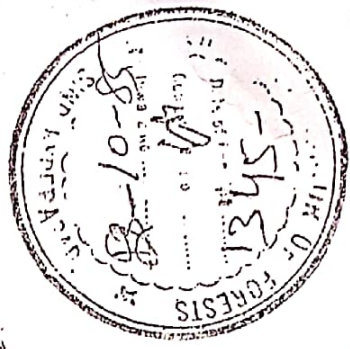

- Divisional Forest Officer (BS-18).
By promotion from amongst Sub-Divisional Forest Officers (except SDFO. Sericulture) possessing 5 years length of service in BS-17 in the Department or such length of service as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

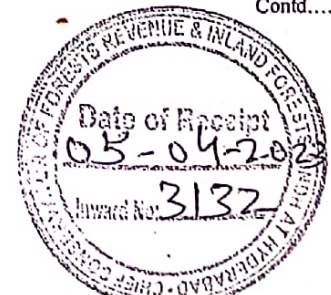

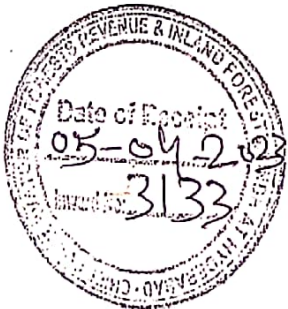
